

## ULTIMedia USA secures contract for NYC passenger kiosks

NEW YORK CITY — Ultimedia USA announced it has received a contract from the New York Metropolitan Transportation Authority to develop a passenger information system.

According to a news release, the system is being developed for the Mineola Intermodal Transportation Center and will include an interactive-kiosk system that assists patrons with information about bus and train schedules. The signage system will be used in a way that resembles flight-information system at airports.

Patrons exiting the trains will be provided bus connection information with digital large formatted LCDs.

Ultimedia will manufacture the kiosks.
